Please Attend or Cancel Your Appointments!

Please, if you cannot attend, call us and cancel. Our process for patients who do not attend or cancel their appointments will be requested to move to another practice. The process is as follows;

1. First letter sent to patients that you have not attended 3 or more appointments in a 12 month period.
2. If they do not attend again we will send a further warning letter, advising that they may be removed from our practice.
3. If they continue to not attend or cancel their appointments, we will send the final letter advising that they have 30 days notice to register with another practice, and we will remove them after 30 days.

If the patient requires reasonable adjustments, due to a disability or dementia etc, we will discuss this with the patient or family and try to assist where we can.

LOOKING AFTER YOU

PROTECT YOURSELF IN THE SUN!

Enjoy a safe and fun summer by focusing on sun protection, hydration, heat safety, and outdoor activity precautions for the whole family.

Sun Protection

Summer sun can be intense, so protecting your family's skin is essential. Use broad-spectrum sunscreen with at least SPF 30, applied 15–30 minutes before going outdoors and re-applied every two hours or after swimming or sweating (endeavorhealth.org). Encourage children to wear hats, sunglasses with UV protection, and light long-sleeved clothing to block harmful rays (kidsbewell.com) Limit outdoor exposure during peak sun hours, typically 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., even on cloudy days (endeavorhealth.org.)

Know When to Call: Contact NHS 111 for advice or 999 in emergencies.
